CHAMPION INTERNATIONAL CHIEF WILL SPEAK AT BUSINESS AWARDS BANQUET

Andrew C. Sigler, chairman and chief executive of Champion International Corp., Stamford, Conn., will be the speaker at the 33rd annual awards banquet of the School of Business Administration at the University of Montana. His topic is "The Future is Your Business."

The banquet will be Friday, May 9, at 7 p.m. in the University Center Gold Oak Room. The program will include the presentation of \$11,445 in scholarships for the 1980-81 academic year.

Sigler, who holds an M.B.A. from the Amos Tuck School of Business Administration, began his career in 1956 with Champion Papers, which merged with U.S. Plywood in 1967. In 1972 he became executive vice president of the newly re-named Champion International Corp. He was elected to the board of directors in 1973 and named chairman in 1979.
