GRIZZLIES TO HOLD ANNUAL
SPRING FOOTBALL GAME MAY 17;
'PIG BOWL' TO FOLLOW

MISSOULA--

Coach Larry Donovan and his University of Montana football staff will put the finishing touches on their 1980 spring practice Saturday, May 17, at 5 p.m., when the annual spring game is played. Immediately after the game the "Pig Bowl," a football game which features local law enforcement officers against Missoula-area businessmen, will be played. That game is scheduled to begin at 6:45 p.m.

"We're looking for a good three hours of football," said Donovan. "Not only do we expect some good competition from the scrimmage, but I think the "Pig Bowl" will be an entertaining event as well."

Donovan and his staff will resume practice in August. The Grizzlies open their 1980 season Sept. 13, hosting Simon Fraser University. Kickoff is at 1:30 p.m.

The spring football game will be at Dornblaser Stadium. Tickets are \$5 per family, \$2 for adults and \$1 for children under 12.
