September 29, 1920

The first meeting of the year of the A.S.U.M. was called to order by President Shepard.

A student convocation committee consisting of the following members was appointed to meet with Mr. Merriam: Bill Johnston, Cora Sparrow, Herbert Vitt, Helen A. Little.

Clyde Murphy made a motion that the above committee be accepted. Motion seconded, passed.

Pat Keeley was named master of ceremonies for the A.S.U.M. mixer to be held in the gym Friday, Oct. 1. Clyde Murphy was appointed to take charge of the orchestra and finances.

Motion made and seconded that the President authorize committee for A.S.U.M. mixer be accepted. Motion carried.

Finances: It was suggested that an auditor be employed to audit the A.S.U.M. books--books to be O.K. by Prof. Coom --the books to be audited every 2 months. Mr. Murphy suggested that Mr. Shaeffer be paid \$.75 per hour for auditing.

Mr. Sullivan suggested an offer be made Mr. Shaeffer and books audited. Mr. Shaeffer to present system and bill when work is completed.

Mr. Murphy made a motion that Mr. Shaeffer audit books and make a statement to that effect and present his bill at the end of that time. Motion seconded and carried.

President Shepard suggested names be brought in at next meeting for appointment of Business manager for Sentinel.

Mr. Sullivan made a motion that Mr. Murphy be directed to obtain a complete report from Elmer Howe in regard to the business management of the Sentinel of last year. Motion seconded and passed.

Budget Committee--suggestions to be made at next meeting.

Constitution Committee--suggestions to be made at the next meeting.
