U ADMINISTRATORS TO ATTEND NATIONAL MEET

The University of Montana will be represented at the 42nd annual meeting of the National Association of Schools of Music by Dean Charles W. Bolen of the School of Fine Arts and Laurence Perry, acting chairman of the Music Department.

The meeting, scheduled Monday and Tuesday (Nov. 21 and 22) in Dallas, Tex., will be addressed by Robert Shaw of the Robert Shaw Chorale; Grant Belglarian, project director of the Ford Foundation, and Frank Dickey, executive director of the National Commission on Accrediting.

The NASM is the official accrediting agency in the United States for all music degree curricula with specialization in the fields of applied music, music theory, composition, music therapy, musicology, and music as a major in liberal arts programs. The UM Department of Music has been a member of the NASM for more than a quarter of a century.
