October 28, 1920

Meeting of the Executive Committee called to order by President Shepard.

Mr. Shepard stated that the leased wire could be put thru for \$48.00. Mr. Sullivan made a motion that the A.S.U.M. go on record as approving the leased wire, and that \$.25 be charged for admission. Motion carried.

Mr. Murphy made a report on the Sentinel with bills outstanding to the amount of \$244. Chas. Roberts appointed to collect Sentinel money and return to Business manager.

Mr. Daylis made a motion to appoint the "Letter a Day" committee to sell the Sentinel during November and December. Motion carried.

Pres. Shepard appointed the following on the "Constitution Revision" committee: Mac Gault, Gertrude Clark, Helen Little, Guy Mooney, Prof. Fisher. On "articles of corporation": Platt, Harpoll, Eric McLaren, Simes.

A motion made and carried to have the regular meeting of A.S.U.M. on 2nd and 4th Thurs. of the month at 8:00 until the football season is over.

Mr. Sullivan made a motion to instruct Chuck Roberts to serve as Business Manager of Sentinel without pay. Motion carried.

Dr. Elrod made a report on the Sentinel.

A motion made and seconded that [the meeting be adjourned.]
