November 23, 1920

Meeting called to order by Pres. Shepard. Charles Roberts, manager of the Sentinel stated that the contract at Showells studio for Sentinel pictures had been made but had not yet been signed.

Sentinel contracts and estimates were discussed.

Mr. Murphy made a motion that the A.S.U.M. committee go on record as advising the Sentinel manager to charge the estimate cost of a page in the Sentinel. Motion carried.

Carolyn McCann made a statement in regard to the Bukby-Mears contract. The President decided that no authorization should be necessary from the A.S.U.M.

Mr. Murphy made a motion that the A.S.U.M. authorize the Business Manager of Sentinel to contract the Bukby-Mears contract for engraving. Motion carried.

Mr. Murphy made a motion that the A.S.U.M. authorize the Howell-Roberts contract according to arrangements--\$2.75 charge for pictures and \$.80 refund to the A.S.U.M. Motion carried.

Motion made and seconded that the refund of \$400 from the pictures be applied to cost of 1920 Sentinel. Sullivan made a motion that the Sentinel go on sale at the next convocation. Motion carried.

The following names were proposed for manager of basketball: DeMers, Watson, Paul Smith.

Mr. Murphy made a motion that the subject of a skating rink be dropped.

Motion made for adjournment.
