GRIZZLIES HOST E. WASHINGTON IN
ANNUAL HOMECOMING CONTEST OCT. 25TH

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana finally returns home this Saturday, Oct. 25, hosting Eastern Washington University in the Grizzlies annual Homecoming game. Kickoff at Dornblazer Field is an half-an-hour later than usual, at 2 p.m. (MDT).

Montana is now 1-5 overall, and has lost its last five straight, after defeating Simon Fraser University of Canada, 60-27 in its opener.

Eastern Washington is 4-2 overall, with wins over Cal State-Sacramento, Carroll College, Whitworth College and Hayward State.

The Grizzlies and Eagles have had one common opponent thus far, Portland State. PSU beat Montana 20-0, and EWU, 54-21.

This will be the eighth meeting of the teams. The Grizzlies have won six of seven times. The most recent game was in 1950, the Grizzlies winning 52-0. The only UM loss in the series was in 1948 (12-7).

KYLT of Missoula will begin its broadcast of the game at 1:40 p.m. The broadcast will begin at 1:50 p.m. on the Grizzly Football Network. Bill Schwanke calls the play-by-play, while Bob Lee provides the color commentary.
