October 1, 1919

The meeting was called to order by Vice-president, Florence Dixon. Plans for the year were discussed.

A motion was made and seconded that the regular executive meeting be held bi-monthly on Monday evening at 7:30.

It was suggested that each member of the executive committee consider people to put on the budget committee, which is to be appointed next Monday night.

After discussing the appointment of a manager for the freshman football team, it was decided that the manager should not be a freshman and that a call be issued in the Kaimin for manager, all men wishing the office to hand in their names to Mr. Ireland before Monday evening.

A motion was made and seconded that President Sisson be asked to postpone the appointment of a faculty representative until Monday afternoon and that a meeting of the executive committee be held Monday at 12:00 to decide upon a man to recommend. Motion passed.

A motion was made and passed that the manager see Mr. Coon in regard to a plan of keeping the books and that Mr. Ireland submit the plans, together with his own, to the executive committee.

A motion was made and passed that the secretary draw up a list of students who have paid their A.S.U.M. fees and of all students who have not paid and that the remainder of Article 10 of the by-laws be left until the "M" book is put out.

A motion was made and passed that Mr. Ireland be appointed a committee of one to review the records for the past few years to verify Mr. Peek's claim to a football sweater and that Mr. Ireland report to committee Monday night.
