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HILL WILL GIVE PIANO RECITAL AT UM

Ford Hill, piano coordinator at Western Washington University, Bellingham, will give a free piano recital Monday, Nov. 17, at 8 p.m. in the Music Recital Hall at the University of Montana.

Hill will play Sonata in E-flat Major, Op. 81a ("Les Adieux") by Beethoven; Suite from "The Firebird" by Stravinsky, and four ballades by Chopin.

Hill, who won a Woodrow Wilson Fellowship for graduate work in performance, studied at Indiana University with the Hungarian pianist Gyorgy Sebok. He won the two highest prizes in performance awarded by that institution--the Performer's Certificate in Piano and first place in the Graduate Concerto Competition.

He has given recitals in many states and has taught at several colleges and universities, including Duquesne University, Pittsburgh, Pa., before joining the WWU faculty in 1975.

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
