Nov. 19, 1919

Meeting was called together by the President. All members were present except DeMers and Johnson.

Mr. Ireland reported on the football expenditures given. The report was accepted.

Mr. McHaffie's report was submitted.

The report of the manager of the Kaimin was read and accepted.

It was moved and seconded that \$200 be released for use by the homecoming entertainment committee.

It was moved and seconded that admissions charged at Bozeman game should not be deducted from students and that notice of this be published in the Kaimin and forwarded to Bozeman for inspection.

Mr. Freeman reported convocation plans. The matter of guaranteeing \$200 to the convocation committee was laid on the table.

It was moved and seconded that the chair appoint a committee to confer with DeLoss Smith about the proposed Glee Club trip. Griffin and DeMers were appointed.

Moved and seconded that manager Frank Gault's services be dispensed with and paid at the rate of \$30 per month.

Moved and seconded that the bill protracted by the band be paid.

Moved and seconded that students of W.S.C. be extended invitation to be guests of A.S.U.M. on Thanksgiving Day. Motion passed.
