SMALL BUSINESS LEGAL PROBLEMS
CONFERENCE AT BIG MOUNTAIN

MISSOULA --

The legal problems of small businesses will be the topic of the 10th annual "CLE & Ski" conference for practicing lawyers Jan. 13-16, at Big Mountain sky resort, Whitefish. The conference will be hosted by the University of Montana School of Law and the State Bar of Montana's Continuing Legal Education (CLE) program.

UM Law faculty members who will speak are Professor William L. Corbett, formerly with the National Labor Relations Board; Professor Ronald Wyse; and Dean John O. Mudd.

Also speaking will be Hendrick De Jong, a partner in the Fagre and Benson law firm, Minneapolis, Minn.; and Rober Mullendore, a partner in the Roberts, Shefelaman, Lawrence, Gay and Moch law firm, Seattle, Wash. The moderator will be James Haughey, a partner in the Billings firm of Croley, Haughey, Hanson, Toole and Dietrich.

The conference will include 15 hours of lectures and panel discussions. Registration costs \$150 and is limited to 150 participants.
