LITERARY MAGAZINE, 'GILT EDGE,'
TO BE PUBLISHED AT UNIVERSITY

MISSOULA--

The Women's Resource Center (WRC) at the University of Montana in Missoula has allocated \$250 to a group of University women students for publication of a literary magazine entitled "Gilt Edge."

Karen Jean Robert, Missoula, said the magazine will be under the collective editorship of a number of community and University women. The \$250 for publication of the magazine is part of \$3,500 allocated recently to the WRC by Central Board, the student governing body of the Associated Students of UM.

Robert said women from the University and community may submit "photographs, drawings, poems, fiction and nonfiction" for publication in the first issue of "Gilt Edge," which is scheduled to be printed in February by the Porky Press of Missoula. Deadline for artwork and other material is Jan. 15. Material for the magazine may be taken to the WRC, room 164 of the University Center.

Commenting on the content of "Gilt Edge," Robert said: "This is an open-submissions magazine. Almost all the material presented for publication will be accepted for use in the magazine."
