FIVE UNIVERSITY COEDS ARE FINALISTS IN FORESTERS BALL QUEEN COMPETITION

MISSOULA--

Five University of Montana coeds have been named finalists in the 58th Annual Foresters Ball queen competition at UM.

The queen, to be selected by students in the UM School of Forestry in a special election Monday through Wednesday, Nov. 25-27, will reign over Foresters Week activities beginning Dec. 2, including the Foresters Ball itself Dec. 6-7 in the UM Men's Gym.

Forestry students will vote for queen from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. Nov. 25-27 in the lobby on the main floor of the UM Forestry Building. The queen will be crowned by last year's queen, Carol Ann Schmidt of Lewistown, during the Foresters Convocation at 8 p.m. Dec. 2 in the University Theater.

UM coeds who are queen candidates, their hometowns and the organizations they represent are: Hertha Marie Feldman, Billings, Alpha Phi sorority; Patricia Ann Boyle, Great Falls, Alpha Omicron Pi sorority; Patricia Eleanora Retzlaff, Duluth, Ga., Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority; Laurie Ann Mlynek, Albuquerque, N.M., Delta Gamma sorority, and Holly Jean Cleator, Vancouver, B.C., Can., representing Miller Hall.

The 58th Annual Foresters Ball will be from 8 p.m.-1 a.m. Friday, Dec. 6, and 8 p.m.-midnight Saturday, Dec. 7, in the UM Men's Gym. Tickets to the ball may be obtained for \$6 per couple from Dec. 2-6 in the University Center.

Profits from the ball provide loans and scholarships for UM forestry students through the UM Forestry Students Association. Loans, which are available to UM forestry students who assist in putting on the ball, are interest free. Scholarships range in value from \$50 to \$200.
