## UM PROF IS AWARDED ARMY COMMENDATION

Major Raleigh R. Meyer, Jr., assistant professor of military science at the University of Montana, was awarded the Army commendation medal by Lt. Colonel Keith Anguin, Commander of the UM Army ROTC unit.

The citation commends Major Meyer for services performed as a Field Artillery Battery Commander and later as Executive Officer for a Field Artillery Battalion in Korea.

As Battery Commander, the citation states, Major Meyer took over a unit that had been involved in a disastrous flood which had seriously impaired the unit's combat readiness. Through Major Meyer's effort, the unit was once more brought into combat readiness.

Major Meyer came to Missoula directly from Korea. He resides with his wife Diana and his daughters, aged 5 and 6, at 3001 Briggs Avenue.

Major Meyer is the son of Mr. Raleigh Meyer, Sr., 4151 N. E. Couch Street, Portland, Oregon.
