The two-year program prepares students for careers as registered physical therapists. Physical therapy is the treatment of the ill and handicapped by physical means such as light, heat, cold, water, electricity, exercise and mechanical agents.

The Mayo School of Health-Related Sciences is part of the Division of Education of Mayo Foundation, Rochester, Minn., a non-profit charitable corporation responsible for the support and conduct of medical education and research as an integral part of health care.
