PROF WILL DISCUSS
MATH IN 1984 at UM

"Mathematics Education--1984" will be the topic of Prof. W. B. Woolf's presentation to the academic year institute and other interested persons on the University of Montana campus Friday (Jan. 13).

In his talk slated for 4 p.m. in MP 311, Dr. Woolf will consider the philosophies and techniques which he thinks will be influential in the near future, according to Dr. Howard E. Reinhardt, UM professor of mathematics.

Dr. Woolf teaches math at the University of Washington. He earned his doctorate from the University of Michigan and recently spent a year in Finland under a Fullbright grant. His special interest is in the problems of mathematics education.
