Parents interested in enrolling their fourth, fifth or sixth graders in a series of Saturday morning art classes should get in touch with Richard B. Reinholtz, chairman of the University of Montana Art Department, or Mrs. Diane Bodholt, art director, School District 1.

The classes, sponsored by the University and District 1, will meet from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. on 10 successive Saturdays, beginning February 11. The first class is scheduled in room 404E in the UM Fine Arts building. A \$5 fee to cover cost of materials at the rate of 50¢ per session is payable at the first meeting.

The art enrichment program to supplement the regular school art curriculum includes instruction in clay, paper mache, printmaking, painting, drawing, sculpture and native materials.
