MONTANA SCIENCE FAIR DEADLINE IS MONDAY

Montana Science Fair hopefuls have only a week left to submit their exhibit entry blanks and scholarship application blanks for the fair, scheduled March 31 and April 1 on the University of Montana campus in Missoula.

According to Dr. Reuben A. Diettert, director of the fair and UM professor of botany, the application deadline is Monday, March 27. Applications should be sent to him at the Missoula unit, 59801. The fair is open to students in grades 7-12.

Registration and setting up of exhibits is scheduled for 8 a.m.-noon, Friday, March 31, in the Men's Gym. The exhibits will be judged in the afternoon, while fair participants attend a program in the University Theater and tour the campus.

The fair will open to the public 6 p.m.-midnight Friday and 8 a.m.-2 p.m. Saturday, April 1. Awards will be presented in the Lodge during a noon luncheon Saturday.

This 12th annual science fair is scheduled in the Men's Gym, instead of the Adams Field House, because of scheduling of the UM Intercollegiate Rodeo in the Field House, March 30-April 1.
