SENIOR PIANO RECITAL IS SCHEDULED FRIDAY

Daniel Shelhamer will present his senior piano recital Friday (April 7) at 8:15 p.m. in the University of Montana Recital Hall, according to Laurence Perry, acting chairman of the Music Department.

Shelhamer will perform Beethoven's Sonata in C Major ("Waldstein"), Chopin's Etude in A Minor ("Winter Wind"), Moussorgsky's "Pictures from an Exhibition," and Prokofiev's Toccata, Op. 11.

Shelhamer, a piano student of Prof. Rudolph Wendt, is an applied music major. He was a member of Jubileers for two years, served as treasurer of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia music fraternity last year, and has held a Missoula Music Teachers Association scholarship. His parents are Mr. and Mrs. Conrad Shelhamer of Bonner.

The recital, which is open to the public without charge, will partially fulfill requirements for the bachelor of music degree.
