CANADIAN ENSEMBLE TO PERFORM
IN PUBLIC CONCERT AT UM WEDNESDAY

The Cassenti Players, a Vancouver, B.C. instrumental ensemble comprising first desk players from the Vancouver Symphony and the Canadian Broadcasting Co. orchestras, will perform in public concert noon ~~Wednesday~~ ^{Thursday} (April 20) at the University of Montana.

Oeganized 11 years ago by bassoonist George Zukerman, the ensemble has been heard during 10 concert tours of the Northwest and California, on numerous radio broadcasts, as well as in many concert demonstrations in schools and community centers.

The ensemble comprises clarinet, oboe, bassoon, violin and piano instrumentalists. Their program will feature Bach's "Trio Sonata in d minor," "Sonata K.292 for Bassoon and Cello" by Mozart, the "Trio for Flute, Bassoon and Piano" by Beethoven, and Gabriel Pierne's "Trio for Flute, Cello and Piano."

The Cassenti Player's Missoula appearance is sponsored by the ASUM Program Council. The public will be admitted without charge to their performance which is scheduled for 12:15 in the UM Music Recital Hall.
