UM BUSINESS ADVISORY COUNCIL
PICKS HAVRE MAN CHAIRMAN;
FIVE NEW MEMBERS

A long-time Havre insurance and savings and loan officer, Stanley O. Snyder, was elected chairman of the University of Montana Business Advisory Council, according to James H. Dion of Helena, retiring chairman.

Snyder has served on the Council which assists the business administration school's faculty since 1965. His term as chairman will end when he retires from the Council next year.

Snyder reported five new council members were selected to replace six retiring members.

The new members are Adrian McClellan, president of the First National Bank of Great Falls, Lee Robinson of Malta, Robert G. Daniels of Lewistown Motors, Paul Husted, editor of the Miles City Daily Star, and E.O. Gillette, senior vice president of the Conrad National Bank of Kalispell.

Retiring members and their years of service are Dion, vice chairman and executive trust officer of the Union Bank and Trust Company, Helena, 1962-67; Russell B. Hart, president of the Hart-Albin Company of Billings, 1959-67; Paul N. Matteucci, president of Super Save Food and Drugs, Great Falls, 1962-67; Robert R. Mountain, certified public accountant, Miles City, 1959-67; and Alex K. Sample, Jr., president of the Conrad National Bank of Kalispell, 1962-67; and Charles B. Anderson, president of the Anderson Grain Company, Great Falls, 1959-67.

The council seeks to improve professional education in business administration and to provide a forum at which faculty members and industry representatives can exchange ideas. It also is concerned with the need for business students' scholarships.
