MUSSULMAN ACCEPTS SUMMER ASSIGNMENTS

Dr. Joseph Mussulman, associate professor of music at the University of Montana, has accepted professional assignments in Oregon in June and North Dakota in July, reports Laurence Perry, acting chairman of the Music Department.

Dr. Mussulman will teach a seminar in the analysis and interpretation of choral music, June 12-23, at the Portland State College Continuation Center.

From July 9-16, he will join the staff of the nine-week International Music Camp at Bottineau, N. D., to direct the mixed chorus and the girls' chorus. On July 16 he will conduct a concert to be performed on the international boundary line between North Dakota and Canada. Dr. Mussulman served on the camp staff in the summer of 1964.
