## SCHWANKE NAMED UM SPORTS INFORMATION DIRECTOR

MISSOULA--

William R. Schwanke, 21, has been named sports information director for the University of Montana, effective June 1. The appointment will accompany a move of sports information from the Athletic Department to the Information Services office.

President Robert T. Pantzer said the sports move will serve to consolidate sports news and general news under the directorship of Larry Stuart, Information Services director.

Schwanke will take over duties handled by Cato Butler, who was Grizzly sports publicist the past year.

Stuart said Schwanke will graduate June 11 with a B.A. degree from the UM School of Journalism. He has had working experience in sports on the Missoulian and the Great Falls Tribune, and with KYLT radio in Missoula.

The former sports editor of the Associated Students' newspaper, the Montana Kaimin, Schwanke is a 1963 graduate of Missoula County High School.

He is a member of Phi Delta Theta social fraternity, Sigma Delta Chi professional journalistic society, and Silent Sentinel, senior men's honorary at UM.
