POLLUTION EXPERT WILL SPEAK WEDNESDAY

YELLOW BAY--

A water pollution expert of national stature will deliver a public address at 7:30 p.m. Wednesday in the new Elrod Laboratory at the University of Montana Biological Station on Yellow Bay.

Dr. Arden R. Gaufin, assistant director of the station and visiting professor of zoology from the University of Utah, will speak on the "Water Quality Requirements of Aquatic Insect." He has accomplished much productive research in water pollution, including a baseline data study on Flathead Lake, which will assist in the control of pollution in that body.

Dr. Richard Solberg, station director, said the interested public is welcome to attend the lecture. Previous to the construction of the new lab, the station was not equipped to handle its own numbers, let alone guests. Solberg said the seminar room in the Elrod lab easily accommodates guests and the station's students.

The station is located 10 miles north of Polson on the east shore highway 35.
