SID STRONG ACCEPTS LEGAL SERVICES POST

MISSOULA --

Sidney Strong, St. Ignatius, has accepted one of the first Reginald Heber Smith Fellowships in the federal economic opportunity legal services program.

A 1967 graduate of the University of Montana School of Law, Strong was admitted to the Montana Bar in June. He was selected from among 300 top applicants.

He currently is attending a special five week training session at the University of Pennsylvania Law School. Following training, he will be assigned to the Seattle OEO agency for at least a year's work there.

The program is named for Smith, who wrote a classic study of "Justice and the Poor" in 1919.
