MENTAL RETARDATION TRAINEESHIP GRANTED

MISSOULA--

A \$5,360 traineeship grant for study of mental retardation has been given to Larry W. Talkington, who is working toward his doctorate in psychology at the University of Montana, Fred S. Honkala, director of research at UM announced.

Mr. Talkington, of Boulder, was awarded the neurological and sensory disease traineeship for the period from Sept. 1, 1967 through Aug. 31, 1968, by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

He received both his bachelor and master's degrees in psychology from Whitworth College, Spokane, Washington.
