SECOND ANNUAL OKTOBERFEST FOR BUSINESSMEN,
UM FACULTY AND ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF
SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 11

MISSOULA--

The second annual Chamber of Commerce-University of Montana Oktoberfest is scheduled for Wednesday evening, Oct. 11. Members of the Missoula business community and UM faculty and administrative staff will join at the Snow Bowl Lodge for the occasion.

The event, which features a Bavarian theme, dinner and refreshments, is sponsored by the Chamber and the UM Foundation. Between 500 and 600 people are expected to attend.

UM President Robert T. Pantzer, who has been named Head Burgomaster or honorary chief for the festivities, said, "The success of the Oktoberfest depends on participation of people from the University community and Missoula business and professional men. It affords a fine opportunity to get acquainted and to enjoy an evening of sociability."

The Oktoberfest will be held from 5 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. Round-trip bus transportation will be available. Buses to the Snow Bowl will originate behind Main Hall on the University campus at 4:15 p.m. and 5:15 p.m. The buses also will stop at the Chamber office, 207 East Main, to pick up downtown participants.

Free chair lift rides before dinner will be an added feature of activities at the Snow Bowl.

Businessmen may make reservations with Jim Burgess, staff member of the Chamber of Commerce. Tom Collins, UM director of Statewide Services, is accepting faculty and staff reservations. The deadline for reservations is Friday, Oct. 6.
