## UM SYMPHONETTE TO TOUR

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana Symphonette, a select group of 32 student musicians conducted by Prof. Eugene Andrie, will perform in Havre and Chester on Sunday, October 29, and in Cut Bank the following day.

The Symphonette has received acclaim from Sylvia Kind, internationally known harpsichordist, for it's performance with her in a recent tour of the northwest area. It has been praised by critics for performances of the operas "The Magic Flute" and "La Boheme".

This season the orchestra will be engaged in a series of concerts featuring outstanding student soloists. Symphonette is also scheduled to present children's concerts and is to play for the opera "Faust" by Founod.

They will appear in Havre at 2:00 p.m. in the Student Union of Northern Montana College on October 29. Following the Havre performance, they proceed to Chester for an 8:00 performance in the Civic Center. On Monday, October 30, they will perform at Cut Bank in the High School Gym at 8:00 p.m.
