BABB ACCEPTS POSITION

MISSOULA--

Harold Babb, professor and chairman of the psychology department at the University of Montana, has accepted membership on the Committee on Advisory Services in Education and Training. The Committee is under the Education and Training Board.

CASET was originally intended to operate the American Psychological Association program of advisory services for institutions requesting consultation on program improvements required for APA approval. It has been expanded to include advisory services for other purposes.

A primary responsibility of the Committee will be to monitor the activities of the APA visiting Scientist Program.

Another activity of the Committee will be to provide a system for disseminating small-scale advice to needy groups on such matters as laboratory arrangements and materials for small colleges, viable introductory courses in various kinds of places and availability of funds for various educational purposes.
