A donation to establish a resident library in the new Elrod Biological Laboratory has been made to Dr. R.A. Solberg, Director of the University of Montana Biological Station on Flathead Lake.

Dr. John Hunter Thomas, curator of the Dudley Herbarium at Stanford University made the donation of several valuable library books and a check valued at approximately \$200. Dr. Thomas has been a summer session faculty member at the Station for the past three years. Dr. Thomas was also instrumental this fall in entering a portrait and biographical sketch of Dr. Morton J. Elrod, Station founder, in the Hunt Botanical Library in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania. The library specializes in botanical books and famous personages of historical interest.
