NEW LAW SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP
TO COMMEMORATE ANACONDA LAWYER

MISSOULA--

A new scholarship commemorating a lawyer who practiced in Montana for 54 years has been funded at the University of Montana law school, according to Dean Robert Sullivan.

The J.B.C. Knight Memorial Scholarship, which will carry a \$500 a year stipend, has been started by Knight's widow, Lorene, a law partner, Wade Dahood, both of Anaconda.

Mr. Knight was graduated from the University of Michigan in 1913.

Dean Sullivan said the scholarship will provide money enough to pay all fees and provide a residue for living expenses and the purchase of legal materials.
