STRING QUARTET TO PERFORM AT UNIVERSITY

MISSOULA--

The Montana String Quartet will perform in the first of a series of chamber music recitals at 8:15 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 21, in the University of Montana Music Recital Hall.

The quartet, comprised of Eugene Andrie, Gerald Doty, Florence Reynolds and Eugene Weigel, all UM music faculty members, will play Mozart and Beethoven selections.

Guest artist Jackie Melvin, violinist, will join Dr. Reynolds in the performance of "Kodaly Duo for Violin and Cello."

The Montana String Quartet has been appearing in the Northwest since 1955, and has planned more than 30 concerts in western Montana this fall. Many of the concert tours include a high school performance, a workshop for music education teachers and a community concert in the evening. Andrie, Dr. Doty and Weigel are violinists. Dr. Reynolds is a cellist.
