A University of Montana faculty member has been elected president of the state of Montana Speech Association.

He is Dr. R. Wayne Pace, chairman of the UM speech communication department. He was named to the MSA presidency during the group's meeting in Helena.

At the same meeting James Polsin, UM speech communication instructor, was appointed to a committee to study speech preparation of high school English teachers.

David M. Fisher, UM speech instructor, who also attended the recent MSA meeting, said that two topics are on the agenda for group's next meeting in Great Falls next April--the exchange of sound and video-tapes among Montana colleges and universities, and a program for cooperation among schools in the state in sharing special lecturers concerning speech.
