UM FOUNDATION TRUSTEES TO MEET IN TWO-DAY SESSION

Twenty University of Montana Foundation trustees will be on the UM campus this Friday and Saturday, Jan. 26-27, for the Foundation's annual winter meeting.

Presiding over his first meeting as president of the board will be Robert C. Hendon, president of REA Express-Seven Arts Transvision, New York City. Hendon, a UM alumnus and former vice president of the board, was elected president of the trustees at their summer meeting last July.

Scheduled to make reports during the two-day session in Main Hall are Robert T. Pantzer, UM president; Oakley E. Coffee, Foundation director; Dr. James D.
