MISSOULA--

University of Montana faculty and staff members have pledged \$9,500 to the 1967-68 United Givers campaign, according to Donovan Worden Jr., Missoula, president of the board of directors for United Givers of Missoula County.

Subscriptions at the University to the United campaign totaled \$7,500 for the 1966-67 fiscal year. A total of \$8,150 was pledged in 1965-66.

Worden said that campaign subscriptions by the University over the years "indicates good University support of this community program." Worden commended Dr. Robert W. Coomrod, dean of the UM College of Arts and Sciences, and Vincent Wilson, UM professor of health and physical education, and others who worked on the most recent drive.
