U SINGERS GIVE RECITAL FRIDAY

Gloria Phillip, mezzo-soprano, and James Selway, bass, will present a free public recital Friday (March 1) at 8:15 p.m. in the University of Montana Recital Hall. Freddi Ibsen, Missoula, will be their piano accompanist.

Selway, a junior voice student of John Lester, will open the program with an aria from Mozart's "Don Giovanni" and a selection by S. de Luca. He will sing an aria from Gounod's "Faust," a song by Samuel Barber, and Benjamin Britten's arrangements of "The Sally Gardens" and "Little Sir William."

Miss Phillip, a sophomore voice student of George D. Lewis, will sing arias from Mozart's "La Clemenza di Tito," Verdi's "Simon Boccanegra," and selections by Barber and Schumann.

The program will close with the aria and duet from Act III of Mousorgsky's "Boris Godounov."

Miss Phillip is a member of Alpha Lambda Delta Scholastic honorary and Mu Phi Epsilon music sorority. Selway is a member of Phi Kappa Phi scholastic honorary. Both belong to Jubileers and both hold music scholarships.
