Course Description: This course is a comprehension-based approach to the learning of Spanish for beginners. It promotes language skills: listening, speaking, reading, writing, and cultural knowledge of some areas of the Spanish-speaking world. The course covers 18 lessons. Each lesson includes a Textbook lesson, a Workbook/Study Guide lesson, and a corresponding half-hour video episode of DESTINOS—an instructional television series. With the exception of the review lessons, every chapter is covered during a four-day period.

Provisions outside of class: Audio Tapes that go with the book are in the Language lab., LA 103. There are also certain lab hours open for viewing the video Check the lab schedule on the lab door for open hours. Video as well as audio tapes can also be checked out at Instructional Media Services (IMS), located in the Mansfield Library.

Grading: 90-100=A, 80-89=B, 70-79=C, 60-69=D, 0-59=F

Your grade will be based on the exams, final exam, quizzes, homework and class participation. Class participation requires that you come to class prepared every day, with your homework done and that you participate in class. For **Pass/Fail** you must receive a **C** grade to receive a **P**.

50% of grade is based on exams and quizzes

30% of grade is based on homework, pop quizzes and class participation

20% is based on the **Final exam**

Exams: There will be no makeups for scheduled exams. However, if you find it necessary to miss an exam, please note that your lowest exam score will be dropped.

Please note: As consistent class attendance is expected, there are no makeups for homework assignments. Your two lowest homework assignments will be dropped, which means that if you miss two homework assignments, the zeroes will be dropped. Homework will be graded on a plus, check and minus basis.
