The University of Montana Symphonic Band will perform in 15 communities during its annual spring tour April 2 through 7.

The band will perform Tuesday, April 2, in Polson, Columbia Falls and Shelby; Wednesday in Conrad, Fort Benton and Havre; Thursday in Chinook and Plentywood; Friday in Fairview, Sidney and Jordan; Saturday in Roundup and Lewistown, and Sunday, April 7, in Stanford and Great Falls.

Some 60 topflight UM instrumentalists will present a program of both light and serious music. Composers represented include Hindemith, Barber, Kabelevsky, Creston and Bernstein.

The band is directed by Butler R. Eitel, associate professor of music. Bruce Schwartz, graduate assistant from Watford City, N. D., is assistant band director.

The April swing around Montana marks the band's first tour under Eitel's direction. Before joining the UM faculty fall quarter he served as conductor, clinician and head of music education at Macalester College in Minnesota. He has been assistant conductor of the U. S. Air Force Band, a member of the conducting staff of the National Music Camp at Interlochen, Mich., and director of several school bands, including the noted Edina-Morningside High School Band in Minneapolis, Minn.
