MISSOULA---

Gov. Tim Babcock will be guest speaker Wednesday (April 3) at the University of Montana in a political lecture series.

Babcock is slated to address law students at 2 p.m. in room 202 of the Law School Building.

The series is entitled "Political Forum 1968." Babcock is the fourth guest lecturer in the series, which is sponsored by the UM law school Student Bar Association.

Main objectives of the series are to provide a forum for the state's political candidates and to inform the law students of the issues the candidates favor and oppose.

Following previous patterns of the series' speakers, Babcock is expected to speak for 10 minutes to the students, allow time for a question-answer period and then visit with the students informally.
