will give a free public concert Monday (April 8) at 8:15 p.m. in the University of Montana Recital Hall.

The recitalists, members of the Indiana University music faculty, will perform works by Heiden, Tcherepnin, Creston, Constant and Dubois.

Dr. Rousseau, that rare musical phenomenon, a classical saxophonist, recently completed his second tour of Europe. Prof. Rezits has also performed extensively as a soloist and, like his colleague, has won critical acclaim from reviewers for major metropolitan newspapers.
