MALCOLM MUGGERIDGE SPEAKS WEDNESDAY NIGHT AT UM

MISSOULA---

Malcolm Muggeridge, former editor of Punch magazine and a noted British journalist and critic, will speak Wednesday night at 9 p.m. in the University theater on the University of Montana campus.

Muggeridge was graduated from Cambridge University at age 20, was a reporter and correspondent from Russia for the Manchester Guardian, and was in the British Intelligence Corps during World War II.

After the war he was a correspondent for the Daily Telegraph in Washington, D.C. and was appointed editor of Punch in 1952, and he served there until his retirement in 1958.

His speech will be free to the public and is sponsored by the Associated Students Program Council.
