RODEO TIME THIS WEEKEND
AT UM; 13 TEAMS COMPETE

MISSOULA---

Intercollegiate rodeo competition comes to the University of Montana campus this weekend when the UM Rodeo Club presents its annual rodeo Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights at 7:30 in the Adams Field House.

Tom Brown, club president, said 13 teams from four Western states will compete in the three-night affair.

The UM Rodeo Club will compete in its first rodeo of the season, fielding a complete team of five men and two women.

Members of the team, their events and hometowns are Brown, Jefferson City, calf roping, bulldogging and ribbon roping; Doug Holzman, Red Lodge, bareback riding, bull riding, saddle bronc riding; Doug Knight, Charlo, bareback and bull riding; Jack Sept, Forsythe, calf and ribbon roping; Dennis Skinner, Malta, calf and ribbon roping, bulldogging; Mary Kitchingman, Great Falls, queen contestant, barrel racing, and goat tying; and Diane Beck, Deer Lodge, queen contestant, barrel racing, goat tying.

Teams competing in the rodeo are from Montana State University, Bozeman; Western Montana College of Education, Dillon; Northern Montana College, Havre; Eastern Montana College, Billings; Ricks College, Rexburg, Idaho; Idaho State University, Pocatello; Washington State University, Pullman; Utah State University, Logan; Brigham Young University, Provo, Utah; Weber State College, Ogden, Utah; and one more team each from Idaho and Utah and Washington.

Last year the Bozeman team won the UM rodeo.
