### SCHOOL BOARD PROGRAM LAUNCHED MAY 3 AT U

MISSOULA---

First phase of a three-part program entitled "College Assistance to School Board Members" gets under way at the University of Montana Friday (May 3) with a series of panel discussions on the Missoula campus.

Friday's program is a workshop for educators from throughout Montana. Harland Seljak, assistant professor of education at the University and workshop director, said he expects approximately 50 for the program.

Chairman is Bruce Milne, former superintendent of schools at Valier, who is studying for his doctorate at the University.

Four panel discussions Friday will deal with the relationship of a school board to the community, government, to school teaching personnel and to administrative personnel.

Friday's program begins at 9 a.m. in the Territorial Room<sup>s</sup> of the Lodge with a discussion by James Kenny, Helena, executive secretary of the Montana School Boards Association.

Presenting the various panels will be Dr. James F. Hall, UM assistant professor of education; Hugh Edwards, executive director of the UM Alumni Association; Willard K. Anderson, superintendent of schools at Polson, who is past president of the Montana Association of School Administrators, and Dr. Vernon O. Sletten, UM professor of education.

Panelists will include Melvin Kastella, White Fish; James Forker, Arthur Sheldon, Richard Griffith, Dale Zunke, and Dr. C.W. Dahling, all of Libby; Geoffrey Brazier, Helena; Roger M. Kensler, Troy; Dr. Gerald Diettert and Arthur Deschamps Jr., Missoula; Vern Lupton, Kalispell; John Manely, Helmville, and Beryl Cooper, Darby.

The workshop is sponsored jointly by the UM School of Education, the Montana School Boards Association and colleges of education throughout Montana.

Phase two of the program will be a meeting in October of the MSBA and phase three will be a November workshop on college and university campuses in Montana.

Parts two and three of the program will be sponsored through Title I (Community Development) of the Higher Education Act of 1965.
