SCIENTIST-AUTHOR
TO SPEAK AT UM MAY 23

Arthur C. Clarke, inventor of the communications satellite and co-author of the book and film entitled "2001: A Space Odyssey," will speak at the University of Montana on Thursday, May 23.

Title of Clarke's discussion at UM is "The Promise of Space." The talk, which is open to the public without charge, will be at 8 p.m. in the University Theater. Clarke's visit is sponsored by the Program Council of the Associated Students at UM.

Clarke, who is a native of England, is author of nearly 40 books, both fiction and nonfiction. His speech deals with political, economic, scientific and cultural implications of the space age.
