### UM FACULTY MEMBER NAMED TO DEVELOPMENT GROUP

Dr. Gloria C. Hewitt, associate professor of mathematics at the University of Montana, has been appointed to the Committee on Regional Development and Centers of Research (CRDCR).

The committee is in the Division of Mathematical Sciences, which forms a major portion of the National Academy of Sciences of the National Research Council.

Dr. Hewitt's appointment is for a three-year term ending June 30, 1971. She is one of six CRDCR members representing different institutions of higher learning throughout the nation.

The CRDCR is concerned generally with encouraging the development of research more uniformly throughout the nation and with ways of achieving this development.

Dr. Hewitt received her doctorate at the University of Washington in 1962. She has been at UM since 1961.
