UM SUMMER SESSION
BEGINS JUNE 17
FOR EXPECTED 2500

MISSOULA---

Both the educational curricula and the cultural and recreational activities of the University of Montana summer session are set to go into full swing Monday, June 17.

Approximately 2,500 students are expected to attend UM during the summer. The anticipated enrollment would represent a 10-15 per cent gain over last summer session's attendance.

Highlights of the first week of UM summer session include a get-acquainted barbecue for both faculty and students to be held in the Oval at 6 p.m. Thursday, June 20, and the opening of the Montana Repertory Theater summer season June 21. A ghost town visitation will be made on June 22.

"Usually at least 45 states and Canada are represented during summer session," Dr. Walter C. Schwank, coordinator of the summer session, said. "This wide-spread student representation is a compliment to the outstanding UM faculty and recreational facilities of Montana."

Students will register by attending the first day of classes. Students may register for either of the two terms, June 17-July 17 or July 18-Aug. 16 or for both of the terms.
