MISSOULA SOPRANO TO GIVE RECITAL FRIDAY

Pearl McGinnis Erny, senior music-education major at the University of Montana, will present a soprano recital Friday (June 28) at 8:15 p.m. in the Recital Hall. She will be assisted by her sister, Marith Willis, soprano, and Charles Bryson, tenor. Monica Hartwig will be piano accompanist.

Mrs. Erny's solos include songs by Brahms, arias from Wagner's "Tristan und Isolde" and Puccini's "Turandot," and two compositions by Gloria Phillip, UM music major from Missoula.

The free recital includes trios by William Cornysh, Thomas Weelkes and Carl Maria von Weber and duets from Mozart's "Le Nozze di Figaro," Bizet's "Carmen," and Offenbach's "Le Contes d'Hoffman."

Mrs. Willis will sing "Vissi d'Arte, Vissi d'Amore" from "Tosca" and Bryson will sing "Che gelida ma nina" from "La Boheme."

Mrs. Erny studies voice with UM Prof. John Lester and is a member of the University Choir. As a student at Montana State University, Bozeman, she was a member of a USO tour of Europe in 1963-64.

The recitalist's husband, Douglas Erny, is a UM physics major. Her parents are Dr. and Mrs. Ralph Y. McGinnis, Missoula.

Mrs. Willis and Bryson are UM graduates and Miss Hartwig, a sophomore at Gonzaga University, is a UM summer student. All four performers are graduates of Missoula high schools.
