Ulysses Doss, newly appointed University of Montana instructor who will teach Afro-American culture courses during the coming year, will offer a course to the public free of charge during fall quarter.

The course, entitled "A Search for Identity," will deal with the crisis of identity which has affected the American Negro from 1619 to the present day. Any interested person may attend.

The class will be taught Wednesdays, beginning Oct. 2, from 7 to 9 p.m. in the Indian Center Day Nursery located at 401 South Ave. E.

Persons planning to attend the class may register at the door Wednesday, Oct. 2, beginning at 6:30 p.m.

No college credit can be received for the course.
