FIRST TO RECEIVE
GM SCHOLARSHIP AT UM

Patricia A. Ellinghausen, Great Falls, a freshman in art at the University of Montana, has received the first General Motors scholarship ever awarded to a UM student, according to Andrew C. Cogswell, UM dean of students.

Cogswell said the GM awards cover expenses ranging from \$200 to \$2,000. Miss Ellinghausen's award is for \$1,200.

Besides the \$1,200 scholarship the Great Falls girl also received an additional \$198 award for being among the top 20 students among 500 scholastically last spring when she was graduated from Great Falls High School.
