SCHOOL BOARD WORKSHOP ON PUBLIC SCHOOL FINANCE TO BE HELD AT UM IN MISSOULA

MISSOULA---

About 50 Montana school board members and school administrators will attend a workshop on public school finance scheduled for November 8-9 at the University of Montana in Missoula.

The workshop, sponsored jointly by the UM School of Education and the Montana School Boards Association (MSBA), will be directed by Harland D. Seljak, UM assistant professor of education.

Seljak said the workshop is the third phase of a three-part program. Previous sessions in Helena and Missoula dealt with general school problems such as school-board-teacher and community relationships, he said.

Among the speakers participating in the workshop will be J. Francis Rummel, dean of the UM School of Education; James J. Kenny, Helena, executive secretary of the MSBA; Vernon O. Sletten, UM professor of education; John W. Wicks, UM associate professor of economics; Richard Morris, Helena, budget director for the State of Montana; Keith Anderson, Helena, executive vice president of the Montana Taxpayers Association, and Edward Nelson, Helena, executive secretary of the Montana University System.
